#### Vision & Goal

##### Vision:

To support primary school students living in poverty by providing additional schooling, nourishing meals, and a Christ-centered foundation—raising up a bright future in Christ.

##### Goals:

- Lead children closer to God and guide them to salvation.
- Encourage consistency in learning among children.
- Provide hot meals daily to support their physical needs.
- Offer quality education to help them progress to the next academic level.

#### What We Do

##### 1. Additional Schooling Program

We offer a weekday education program for children from grades 1 to 6, providing:

- Khmer, Math, English, and Bible studies
- 2 hours of instruction per day, 5 days per week
- A curriculum aligned with the Cambodian government school system



##### 2. Children Discipleship

Every week, we conduct discipleship and outreach activities with students through:

- Bible stories, worship, prayer
- Games, fellowship, and spiritual mentoring

### 3. Feeding Program

- We provide one hot lunch each day from Monday to Friday
- This not only improves students' physical health but also reduces financial stress on families

#### I. Impact and Reach (January to June 2026)

- Total number of students served: 30
- Program schedule: 5 days per week, 2 hours per day + daily lunch
- Team involved:
  - 1 Pastor
  - 1 Program Facilitator
  - 2 Teachers
  - 2 Cooks

#### II. Success Stories & Highlights (1<sup>st</sup> January to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026)

##### 1. Spiritual Growth:

- Fifteen children now faithfully attend Sunday School each week. They are growing in their faith through memorizing Bible verses, singing worship songs, participating in Bible lessons, and playing fun, faith-building games with their Sunday School teachers.
- The children continue the meaningful practice of praying before lunch, offering thanks and gratitude to God. This simple yet powerful habit nurtures their spiritual growth, strengthens their faith, and encourages them to rely on God in their daily lives.

## 2. Character Transformation:

- Noticeable improvement more good morality, respecting other especially teacher and older, love and understanding among the students.
- The hygiene education program has encouraged the children to adopt healthy daily routines. They consistently wash their hands before meals, clean their dishes after lunch, and take responsibility for keeping their classrooms, tables, and surrounding dining areas clean. Through these practical activities, the children are developing self-reliance, personal responsibility, and lifelong habits that promote health, cleanliness, and teamwork.



## 3. Academic Progress:

- 75 percent of students have shown great improvement—some now confidently read and solve math exercises.
- Conducted regular weekly reading gatherings every Thursday in our little library room.
- Teachers closely monitored and prioritized students' homework in each class.



#### 4. Family Impact:

- Our facilitator and teachers maintained strong relationships with students' families by regularly communicating with parents through phone calls and home visits, strengthening family engagement and support for students' learning.

#### 5. Students Impact:

- Through the hard work and dedication of our Feeding Ministry team, most of the students who attend our extra classes have shown significant growth in both their education and character. Their reading, writing, and mathematics problem-solving skills have improved noticeably. We are also encouraged to see positive changes in their attitudes, discipline, and willingness to learn.

This semester, **six students** will complete Grade 6 and move on to **Grade 7 at secondary school**. This is an important milestone in their education, and we are very proud of their achievements.

Please keep these students in your prayers as they prepare for this next step. We hope that, through the support of the Feeding Ministry and God's guidance, they will successfully continue their education and do well in secondary school.

### III. Challenges Faced

#### Challenge:

- About 50% of our students arrive a little late to the program each day. After finishing primary school, they often go home first to change their clothes instead of coming directly to the feeding program.

#### Solution:

- Facilitators and teachers encouraged all students to arrive on time and consistently reminded them to follow the feeding program's rules and schedule.



#### IV. Extra-Activities:

During this semester, we organized an educational field trip for the Feeding Program students to visit Phnom Tamao Wildlife Rescue Centre in Takeo Province, which borders Kampot Province Where our program is located. The students were excited to see a variety of animals and enjoyed Learning about wildlife. After exploring the zoo, everyone shared a picnic lunch together in the Zoo's Picnic area. It was a joyful experience that created wonderful memories for the students, Teachers, and facilitators.

Sokharath is a diligent and responsible student who attends classes regularly and always tries her best to learn. She is attentive during lessons, completes his homework consistently, and shows a positive attitude toward her studies. Her teachers have been encouraged by her willingness to learn and her steady progress throughout the semester.

Academically, Sokharath has made significant improvements. Her Khmer handwriting has become much neater and easier to read and her mathematics skills have also become much stronger, especially in basic calculations and problem-solving. These improvements are the result of his hard work, the encouragement of her teachers, and the consistent support provided through the Feeding Ministry.

**Vork Sarunlyhour** is a Grade 4 student whose life has been beautifully transformed through the Feeding Ministry at New Life Fellowship Hosana Krong Kampot Church.

When Sarunlyhour first joined the program, he struggled both academically and behaviorally. He often used disrespectful language, became angry easily, argued with classmates, and had difficulty following instructions. He rarely paid attention during lessons, which affected both his learning and his relationships with others. Despite the patient guidance and encouragement of our teachers and facilitators, just a little improvement was seen, and the ministry team began discussing whether he should continue in the Feeding Program.

At that critical time, Sarunlyhour's father met personally with our facilitator. With humility, he apologized for his son's behavior and asked us not to give up on him. He shared, "**Please don't give up on my son. I know he has made many mistakes, but I believe he can change. I promise to do my part as his father by encouraging him, disciplining him with love, and working together with the teachers. Please give him one more chance.**"

His sincere commitment deeply touched our ministry team. Believing that every child deserves hope and another opportunity, we prayerfully decided to continue supporting Sarunlyhour through the Feeding Ministry.

That decision became a turning point in his life. With the faithful support of his father and the loving care of our teachers and facilitators, Sarunlyhour gradually began to change. Today, he is a respectful, obedient, and responsible student who attends the program faithfully, follows classroom rules, and enjoys helping his classmates.

His academic progress has also been remarkable. In **Khmer**, he can now fair spell, read and write confidently. Opposite at the first he can't even spell or read. In **Mathematics**, his calculation skills have improved significantly.

Spiritually, Sarunlyhour has begun taking positive steps in his faith journey. Through Bible lessons, prayer, and the love of the Feeding Ministry team, he is learning about God's love and the values of kindness and respect. Recently, he visited our church for the first time, observed Sunday school, and joined the worship service. We are encouraged by this step and will continue to follow up and support his spiritual growth.



Sarunlyhour's story reminds us that no child is beyond hope. Through the partnership of a caring family, dedicated teachers, and the love of Christ, lives can be transformed. **Davy** is an 11-year-old Grade 4 student who lives about one kilometer from New Life Fellowship Hosana Krong Kampot Church. She joined the **Feeding Ministry during the second semester, 2025** and although she has been with the program for a relatively short time, she has already shown encouraging growth in both her education and character.

When Davy first joined the program, she was a very shy and quiet girl. Although she attended school regularly, she lacked confidence in the classroom and was hesitant to participate in learning activities. Her handwriting was difficult to read, her reading ability was limited, and she often struggled with basic mathematics. She rarely asked questions because she was afraid of making mistakes.

Through the consistent support of the Feeding Ministry, the patient encouragement of her teachers, and the loving environment of the program, Davy has gradually gained confidence and developed a love for learning.



Today, Davy attends the program faithfully and works hard in every lesson. She has made significant academic progress. Her Khmer handwriting is now neat, clear, and accurate. She has become a much stronger reader, her mathematics skills have improved greatly, and she listens carefully to her teachers' instructions and applies what she learns in class. Her teachers are encouraged by her diligence and willingness to learn.



Davy is also known for her gentle, respectful, and humble character. She is quiet, well-behaved, and treats both teachers and classmates with kindness. Her positive attitude has made her a wonderful example to other students.

Spiritually, Davy is growing through Sunday school lesson, prayer, and the love she experiences in both the Church and the Feeding Ministry. We continue to encourage and support her as she grows in her understanding of God and becomes more involved in church activities.
